a. Percentages to be Submitted to Actuary

The Board of Directors, Chief Sackett and Attorney Ross discussed the fact that a new actuarial report will be prepared in 2023 by the actuary for the Fire and Police Pension Association of Colorado ("FPPA"). FPPA administers Fund 7247-5 and Fund 7306-5. In addition to determining the actuarial soundness of the Funds, the District can, at no additional cost, request that the actuary determine the actuarial soundness of the Funds if the benefits were increased by two different percentages.

Following the discussion, Trustee Savage made a motion to recommend to the District Board that the actuarial study for Pension Fund 7247-5 determine the actuarial soundness of the Fund if the benefits were increased by 3.0% or by 5.0%. Trustee Burris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Trustee Seifert made a motion to recommend to the District Board that the actuarial study for Pension Fund 7306-5 determine the actuarial soundness of the Fund if the benefits were increased by 3.0% or by 5.0%. Trustee Burris seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
