Open Public Hearing – 2024 Budget

a. Continued Review of Proposed 2024 Budget

Fire Chief Sackett reviewed the District's updated 2024 Budget Scenarios, including the Lean, Moderate, and Aggressive approaches. The Lean scenario includes a 5% premium increase in workers' compensation and medical benefits. The Moderate scenario includes a \$20,000 budget for Honor Guard training and expenses, a \$15,000 budget for an Assessment Center for lieutenants and battalion chiefs, and a 5% COLA (Cost-Of-Living Adjustment). The Moderate scenario also includes the hiring of a Training Captain and three additional personnel that were not hired this year. The Aggressive scenario includes the addition of \$792,000 into the Burning Mountain Fire Protection District (BMFPD) Pension Fund as well as funds for buildings.

Further Board discussion ensued.

The Board provided direction for Chief Staff to focus, and provide additional information, on the Moderate scenario at the December 2023 continued public hearing on the 2024 Budget.
